The Muzzle Stuffers shoot at the Rio Salado range in East Mesa on the 2nd and 4th Sundays of the months. There is a small fee to shoot to cover the range fee. They shoot for bragging rights so the range fee of 10 or 5 dollars the only cost See the link at the end of these notes. The range gate opens at 6:30 and shooting usually begins at 8:00. Be there a little early to set up and get the low down on the shoot for the day.

Mazatzal has a target maintenance fee of \$1 per shooter and \$3 for insurance for non-members.
