- Pete called the meeting to order at 12:35 just after lunch and prizes.
- It would be real nice to see a few more MMM shooters at the Muzzle Stuffers shoots. Black powder is a small division at Rio Salado and needs the support to maintain it's standing at the range
- We have FF thru FFFF Powder
 - For members only, \$20.00 **Donation** /Lb for Goex powder. Non-members \$23.00
 - Need it? Want it? Got to show up at a club shoot/meeting to get it.
- Members kick in \$2 at the monthly shoots for target maintenance and Guests will be \$5 (insurance \$3 and targets \$2).
- Non-member fees for the Rendezvous is \$25 for a single and \$40 for a family that lives under the same roof.
- Pete reported on the purchase of 3f Goex powder for the club, that was approved by vote last month. Pete contacted all known distributers of Goex powder, they said there isn't any powder available until the middle of this June. On Thursday April 8th I called Craig with Bear River Powder Co. back and he said he had set aside one case of 3f Goex for me and would ship it to us on April 13th. The price would be \$450.00 for 25 pounds, around \$37.00 for Hazard Fees and around \$30.00 for Shipping for a Total of around \$510.00. Members were relieved that we could get some powder before June.

New Business:

- Pete thanked everyone for attending and helping with the shoot.
- Pete reported on the March 29th Muzzle Stuffers' shoot at Rio Salado. It was well attended with a variety of targets to shoot. There were good comments for having the shoot held on a Monday which was a great idea and they would attend it again. No other event was attended.
- Pete welcomed 3 visitors. Mike Peterson (Stephen Waichulaitis' Father-in-Law), Dion Tornincasa (who joined the club), and Nick Tornincasa (Dion's son). Now that Dion has joined he is fair game for shooting harassment, though lets take it easy on him at least till his son joins the club. Welcome to all three.
- John Schaffer announced that the AMLA (Arizona Muzzle Loading Association) has been dissolved and will not be sponsoring the annual El Verano Family Shoot the first weekend in August. John said there will be a gathering of muzzleloaders in August somewhere up north to replace the El Verano. John will let us know if and when the gathering will occur and where it will be located.
