Our club is named the Mazatzal (Yavapai for Land of the Deer) Mountain Muzzleloaders. The club was organized in 1986 and has been an NMLRA chartered club since 1988. We would like to invite anyone interested in Traditional Black Powder shooting to attend any of our club events.

Our yearly Rendezvous is held in November around Veteran's Day weekend. Rendezvous setup starts Wednesday prior to the second Saturday of November finishing with prizes given out Sunday morning. The location is just south of Rye, Arizona where there are separate primitive and modern camp sites available with plenty of space to accommodate any size of camp. Although we encourage primitive dress it is not required. Traders are warmly welcomed. Bring the entire family so they can participate in all of the activities.

Monthly club shoots are held on the second Saturday weekend of each month. During the months of October then December through April the club shoots are held just north of Sunflower, Arizona. While during the months of May through September the club shoots are held just north of Mormon Lake, Arizona. The monthly club shoots are casual and camping is encouraged.





The following map is of our winter club shoot area just north of Sunflower, Arizona. From northbound State Highway 87 at mile marker 219 turn right and follow Forest Road 385 northeast for about a mile to the top of the hill on the right. From southbound State Highway 87 just past mile marker 219 turn left at Bushnell Road crossover and head northbound then follow above directions.



The following map is of our summer club shoot area just north of Mormon Lake, Arizona.

From Mesa drive north on State Highway 87 through Payson, Strawberry, Pine and then Clint's Well which is about 116 miles. Then a half mile past the Clint's Well Cafe turn left on County Highway 3 (Lake Mary Road) for another 35 miles then near mile marker 324.5 (Forest Road 9488E) turn right and enter the cattle gate. From the cattle gate stay on the left gravel road, the gravel pit is about a half mile in on the right side, and camping is anywhere under the pines.



The following map is of our Annual Rendezvous on Rye Creek site just south of Rye, Arizona. From Mesa drive north on Highway 87 for 62 miles to mile marker 239 ¼, which is just south of the Rye Creek Bridge, just look for our MMM signs. Turn east onto the paved entry passing through a cattle guard then a small wash, in less than 1/8th you'll see the camp.

From Payson drive south on Highway 87 south for 15 miles then turn left using same entry directions as above.

Our 36th Annual Mazatzal Mountain Muzzleloaders Rendezvous will be held November 8th through 12th 2023 at the Rye gravel pit site. The site is just south of the Rye Creek bridge on the east side of Highway 87.
