We should be good with Fires this year. ALL fires must be in a contained fire barrel. Be sure to keep your fires away from any trees, clear UNDER & AROUND your fire ballel, NO in-ground fires,. You must either douse your fires or cover your fires at night...There are ash barrels around camp to put your ashes in when you leave Rendezvous. NO EXCEPTIONS, PLEASE

#### • camp Set up in Primitive:

THIS IS A PRIMITIVE CAMP AND PEOPLE COME TO ENJOY THE SERIOUSNESS OF PRIMITIVE CAMP. WE NEED TO KEEP THAT ATMOSPHERE THROUGHOUT RONDY...

<u>REMEMBER</u> - ALL PRIMITIVE CAMPERS, YOUR VEHICLES MUST BE PARKED OUT IN THE PRIMITIVE PARKING AREA even before rondy starts- NO EXCEPTIONS. We need to keep the public parking spaces open for the public. (when people see someone parked in public parking they think it's ok to park there and then we are chasing who the vehicles belong to)

After the final set-up weekend (weekend before Rondy) and until Wednesday, vehicles are only allowed in primitive camp for 2 hours and then <u>must be moved to primitive parking</u>. From Wednesday afternoon thru Friday 6:00, vehicles can come in but only allowed 45 minutes to unload, take their vehicles out, to primitive parking, come back and set up camp...

AFTER WEDNESDAY 7:00 PM, NO TRAFFIC OR CAMPS CAN GO DOWN THE MAIN ROAD, THRU TRADERS ROW. YOU WILL NEED TO TAKE THE BACK ROAD... RENDEZVOUS STARTS ON THURSDAY.

AFTER FRIDAY 6:00 PM, NO TRAFFIC IS ALLOWED anywhere IN PRIMITIVE - HAND CARTS ONLY MUST BE USED. UNLOAD THE CARTS AT YOUR CAMP SPOT AND BRING THEM BACK IMMEDIATELY TO THE CART PARKING AREA BY REGISTRATION SO THEY'RE AVAILABLE FOR SOMEONE ELSE. TO USE.

"ONLY ONE VEHICLE TRIP IN "IS ALL THAT'S ALLOWED - THURSDAY THRU SUNDAY ... no vehicles are allowed into the primitive camp until 1:00 PM sunday . We advertise rondy is 1/2 day sunday and we can't have vehicles blocking the main road to traders row. traders are to stay open until 1:00 pm.. You can tear down your camps and then bring your vehicles in after 1:00 thank you

- Parents are responsible for children at all times. Please know ALL event range boundaries and keep your children out of those areas. WATCH FOR <u>SNAKES, COYOTES AND MOUNTAIN LIONS</u>. This is a primitive camp and there are critters that roam at night <sup>©</sup>
- All animals MUST be on a lease, kept quiet, restricted to your campsite and cleaned up after. NO EXCEPTIONS!!

- Pre-1840 Dress is required in primitive camp after 7:00 pm for all Rendezvous participants and guests (If you haven't gotten all your clothing yet, please be as period as you can)
- **Event Awards at Council** Prize pickin' order. If you win a 1,2,3rd place in any of our events and are not able to attend Sunday Awards Council, the winners (no matter what place) that are present will pick first and your gift will be chosen last. Your gift can be picked up by someone that can get your gift to you or we will make every attempt to get your prize.
- A Few reminders and changes to a few of the events:

1. SILHOUETTE SHOOT IS RUN BY WOLFE (Keith McClenahan). he sets the rules for this event. THIS YEAR, <u>PRIZE FOR TOP SCORE ONLY - IN BOTH RIFLE & PISTOL WILL RECEIVE \$100.</u> <u>YOU MUST BE AT SUNDAY COUNCIL FIRE, IN PERIOD DRESS (as good as you have) TO RECEIVE</u> <u>YOUR PRIZE. 2. SHADOW THROW - FRIDAY NIGHT - This event is held at the practice hawk blocks on the main road at dark. It's open for 12 and older participants (Juniors on up - Men or Women). you will need to have your participation medallion (Beaver) with you to show Slow-Paw.

3. Practice Knife & Hawk Blocks on Main Road . <u>CHILDREN UNDER 12 MUST HAVE AN</u> ADULT WITH THEM WHENEVER THEY ARE THROWING (Ins & safety)

4. Tin-Tee-Pee - Remember to keep at least 10' between your RV's. Those of you that have smaller Camper or RV's please find one of the smaller spaces in length to leave spaces for the longer RV's. Please park vertically (like an RV park) so we have room for other participants. Please make sure that you have access to get out of your spots in case of fire and make sure you know where the fire exits are, there is map posted on camp bulletin boards or ar registration. There are a few shorter spaces cleared of sagebrush on the right hand side of the road just before you go under the big site sign.. The site this year has small desert grasses growing so you may want to clear some of

those. when you're parked.
